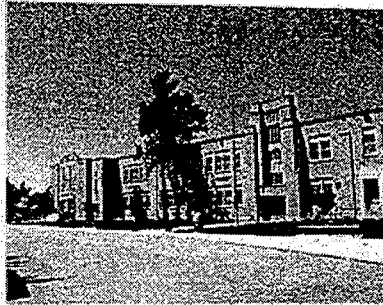

The Educational Facilities Master Plan includes the following work at Louisville Middle School:

Facility Condition Assessment (FCA):

- Communication systems improvements
- Irrigation system upgrades
- Repair or replace asphalt and concrete paving
- Upgrade electrical service and distribution
- Interior Signage Program

Program Compatibility Assessment (PCA):

- Reconstruct original part of building
- Provide special education spaces
- Enlarge IMC
- Enlarge auditorium/music area
- Enlarge elective area

Multi-Use Outdoor Facilities (MUOF):

- Drainage improvements for the playfield and running track
- New athletic equipment storage building

Information Technology (IT):

- Upgrade WAN to provide capacity to support applications with high bandwidth demands
- Upgrade LANs to provide reliable and responsive access to data, research, and information
- Implement VoIP to enhance communications capabilities and reduce costs
